
TELEMEDICINE

You have been scheduled for a TeleMedicine appointment with one of our providers. In an effort to create a seamless experience, please review the following information below:



You will receive an email invitation prior to your scheduled appointment with a link to access the Doctor's Virtual Waiting Room through doxy.me. Please click that link 30 minutes prior to your scheduled appointment. Please check your spam folder if you have not received the email 30 minutes prior to your appointment. When prompted, allow your browser to use your camera and microphone.

Patient Consent

By entering the Doctor's Waiting Room, you are consenting to the following:

"This documentation is for a telehealth audio/video encounter which was performed in lieu of an in-person office visit due to the COVID-19 emergency. Physical exam was limited to components that were ascertained via remote live video. An in person office visit with a physical exam is the best means to establish an accurate diagnosis, but the risk of this encounter was deemed too high. The patient was made aware of this, was also made aware that portions of this encounter may not be fully HIPAA compliant, understands this compliance has been waived due to the emergency, and has given verbal permission to proceed with this telehealth encounter in place of an office visit."

HOW DO I PREPARE FOR MY APPOINTMENT?



If using your phone, we recommend turning your audio and video access to "allow" prior to your appointment. This can typically be completed through the "Settings" icon on your phone.

Be prepared to receive a phone call from your physician's staff on the day of your appointment, and this call may be coming from a restricted number.

Please have the following information available:




Medication List Medical History/ Family Medical History Allergies


